Other appointments include Senior Enterprise Fellow, University of Essex; International Fellow, Anglia Ruskin University Cambridge; International Research Fellow, Laurea University of Applied Sciences in Helsinki and at University of Lahti also in Finland; and Professor of Practice of the HKMA Institute of Advanced Management Development.
