4. PROGRAMME FEES

The fee for the whole programme is HK\$73,500 to be collected in 6 instalments of HK\$12,250 each and is a composite fee including:

- Registration with the University
- Induction Seminar
- Intensive Seminars by lecturers from the University
- Local Study Group
- Examinations in Hong Kong
- Access to Library Facilities
- Study Notes and Essential Textbooks
- Local Administration Support

The programme fees are payable every 2 months prior to the commencement of each subject. Students should note that all fees are subject to review and may be changed by the University.
